

**SPRING ARBOR TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING  
MARCH 5 & 6, 2010**

*Friday* A special meeting of the Spring Arbor Township Board of Trustees was convened at 4:00 pm on Saturday, March 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> for the purpose of interviewing, selecting, and appointing a new clerk to replace the current clerk who is resigning. The following members were present: Supervisor Marston Fortress, Treasurer Colleen Gibbs, and Trustees Joel Freehling, Troy Ganton, Brent Williams and Patricia Short. Absent: Clerk Randi Holthouse.

The following candidates were scheduled for half-hour interviews in the following order using the Board's adopted job description as a basis of the Board member's questions of the candidates and choice for clerk. On Friday, March 5<sup>th</sup> candidates Julie Stonestreet, Holly Lazor, Teresa Walters, Richard Minier, Steve Bringham, and Wendy Thomson were interviewed.

The meeting recessed until the 9:00 am the following morning. Candidates Roxanne Taylor, Fred King, David Mayotte, and Deborah Maxwell were interviewed.

After consideration of the various candidates' strengths and weaknesses compared to the Board's adopted job description, it was moved by Troy Ganton and seconded by Joel Freehling that the Board offer the appointment to Julie Stonestreet. The motion had unanimous support.

In discussion, it was agreed that the Supervisor would promptly contact Mrs. Stonestreet and offer her the position, negotiating the start date, the salary, and the schedule. The meeting was adjourned at 11:47am.
